**COURSE 1A HIAB CRANE OPERATOR
CERTIFICATION TRAINING**

(Certification course for experienced operators)

This one-day course combines practical and theoretical aspects of crane safety and operation, and meets the intent of the Occupational Health and Safety Act (Ontario) regulations. A 0-8 Ton Certificate and Operator's Card is issued upon successful completion.

PREREQUISITE: MINIMUM 40 LOGGED HOURS

**COURSE 1B HIAB CRANE OPERATOR
PRE-CERTIFICATION TRAINING**

This half-day course prepares you for course 1A. It combines written elements, hands-on training, and a one-on-one practice session with your crane. Continuing the safety focus, operators should follow the course with a minimum of one-month working hands-on with an articulated crane, accompanied by a registered, accredited operator.

At Atlas Polar, safety is always a priority. Please see the reverse for COVID-19 protocols and operator expectations.

NOTE: HIAB crane to be used for training must be provided by the operator and brought to the training facilities at Atlas Polar on course day. Atlas Polar will not provide equipment.
