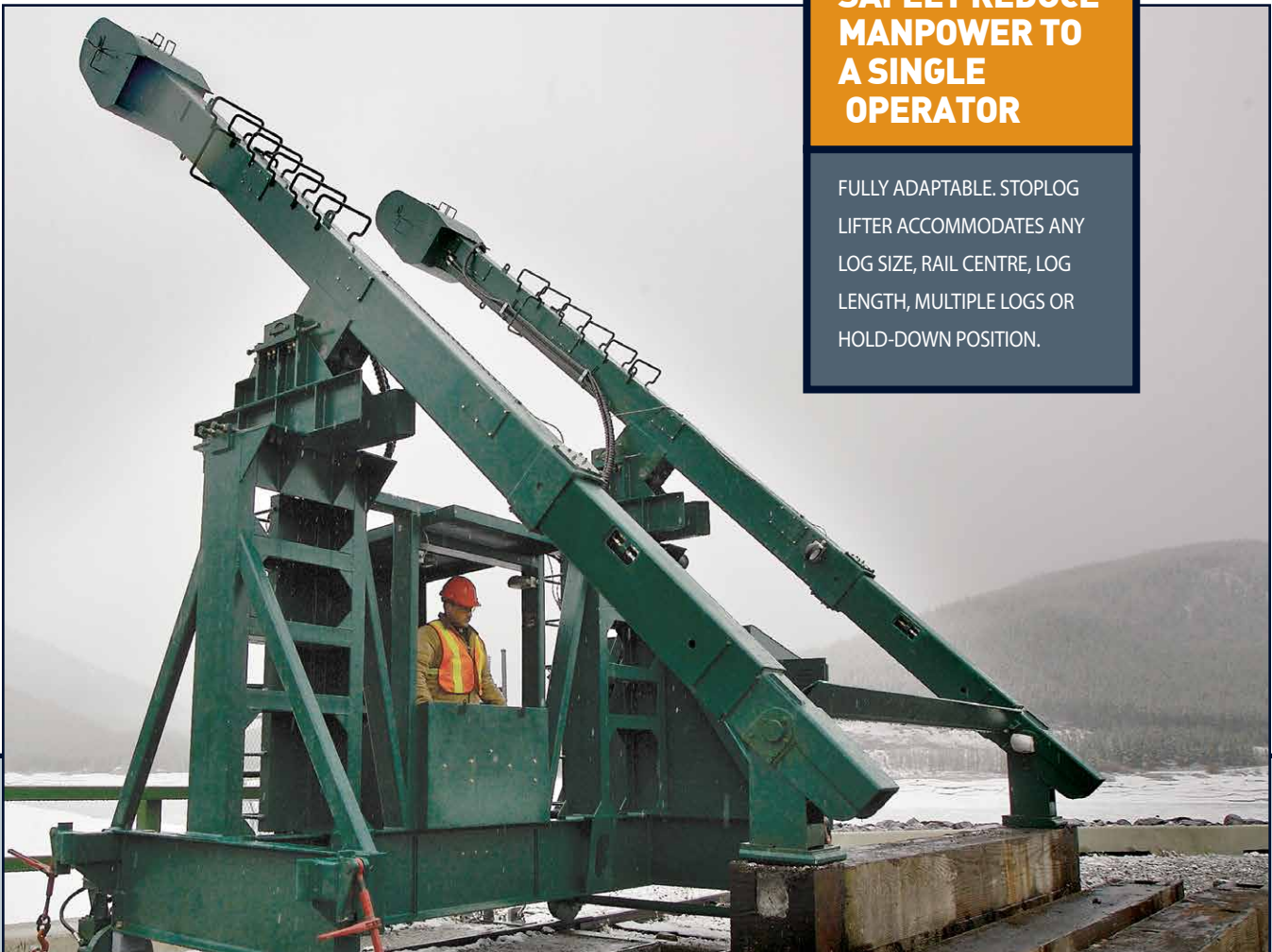

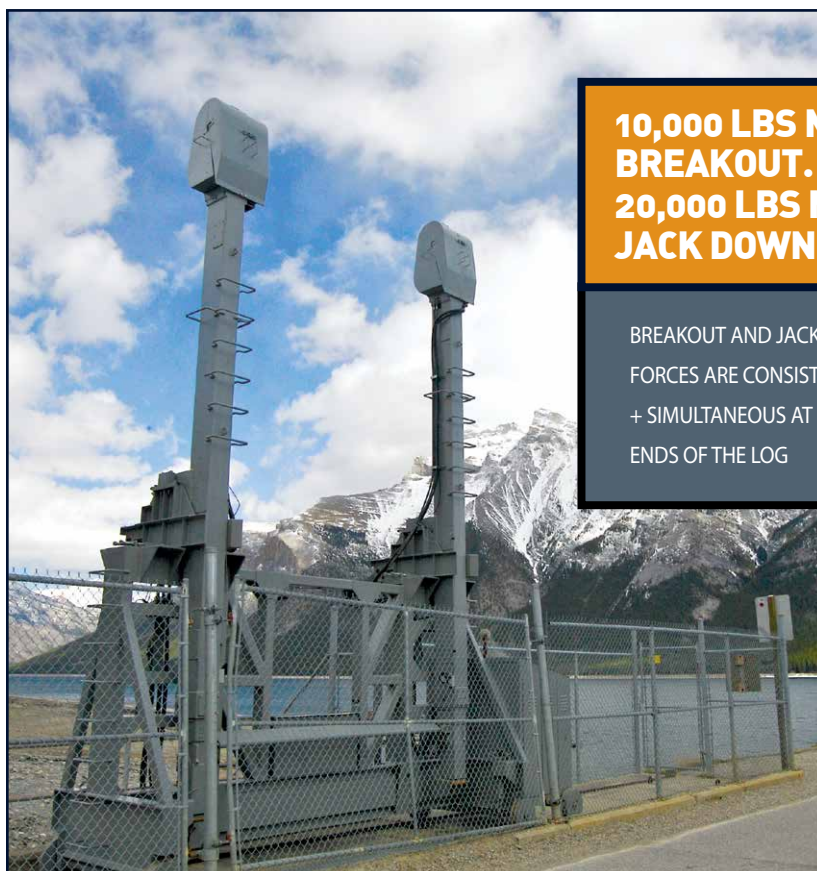

AT A GLANCE

- Booms bottom on the log at 2800 psi while a second gauge turns the head at 1500 psi.
- Operator has a clear view of the operation at all times and is protected from weather
- Individual gauging for each boom system
- Stacks and retrieves logs from the downstream deck
- Double-braid, high pressure hydraulic hoses, electric motor, pump, oil reservoir and control bank contained protected in lockable enclosure.

- Engages logs even under a full head of water
- Breakout/lifting force: 10,000 lbs min.
- Jack down/compacting force: 20,000 lbs. max
- Travel speed along dam: 25 ft/min out + in
- Boom speed: 25 ft/min out + in
- Clearance: 6 in. min between log + dam
- Remove from any sluice up to 30 ft. depth
- Safe clear view at all times from centred weather-protected operator platform
- Lockable enclosed electric motor, pump oil reservoir and control bank (propane option)
- Double-braided high-pressure hoses
